## BYOD Notebook Program Device Specifications

Please note that student laptops can be purchased from any retailer that you choose and must meet or exceed the minimum specifications below.

CPU	Dual core processor
Memory	8GB
Hard Drive	128GB minimum however 256gb would be optimal
Keyboard	Must have physical keyboard (not a tablet)
Display	11" minimum
Wireless	802.11 ac
Operating System	Windows 10 or 11 (not Window 10 S mode) or Apple OSX
Memory card reader	Yes – external USB card reader acceptable
Battery	Minimum of 6 hours

## **BYOD Minimum Requirements:**

Tablets, Android devices and iPads are not currently included in the BYOD program. The device must be accompanied with laptop bag.

A Microsoft office account is available for students to install using their Department of Education account. E.g. <u>example@schools.vic.edu.au</u>

This will be provided to the student from the college.

Microsoft Office (Word, PowerPoint, Excel etc) does not need to be purchased separately.
